

## RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION SUMMARIZING REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES FOR EACH FUND, ADOPTING A BUDGET, LEVYING GENERAL PROPERTY TAXES FOR THE YEAR 2001 TO HELP DEFRAY THE COSTS OF GOVERNMENT, AND APPROPRIATING SUMS OF MONEY TO THE VARIOUS FUNDS IN THE AMOUNTS AND FOR THE PURPOSES SET FORTH HEREIN FOR THE ALPENSEE WATER DISTRICT, SUMMIT COUNTY, COLORADO, FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR BEGINNING ON THE FIRST DAY OF JANUARY, 2001, AND ENDING ON THE LAST DAY OF DECEMBER, 2001,

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Alpengsee Water District has authorized its consultants to prepare and submit a proposed budget to said governing body at the proper time; and

WHEREAS, the proposed budget has been submitted to the Board of Directors of the District for its consideration; and

WHEREAS, upon due and proper notice, posted in accordance with the law, said proposed budget was available for inspection by the public at a designated public office, a public hearing was held on November 27, 2000, and interested electors were given the opportunity to file or register any objections to said proposed budget; and

WHEREAS, whatever increases may have been made in the expenditures, like increases were added to the revenues so that the budget remains in balance, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, at an election held on November 2, 1999, the District has eliminated the revenue and expenditure limitations imposed on governmental entities by Article X, Section 20 of the Colorado Constitution and Section 29-1-301, C.R.S., as amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE ALPENSEE WATER DISTRICT OF SUMMIT COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1. 2001 Budget Revenues. That the estimated revenues for each fund as more specifically set out in the budget attached hereto are accepted and approved.

Section 2. 2001 Budget Expenditures. That the estimated expenditures for each fund as more specifically set out in the budget attached hereto are accepted and approved.

Section 3. Adoption of Budget for 2001. That the budget as submitted, and attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, and if amended, then as amended, is hereby approved and adopted as the budget of the Alpensee Water District for calendar year 2001.

Section 4. 2001 Levy of General Property Taxes. That the foregoing budget indicates that the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for the General Fund for operating expense is \$ 0 and the amount necessary to balance the budget for the Debt Service Fund for retirement of debt, bonds and interest thereon and payment of any contractual obligation approved by a majority of the qualified electors of the District is \$19,781, for a total of \$19,781. That the 2000 valuation for assessment, as certified by the Summit County Assessor, is \$659,380.

A. Levy for General Fund. That for the purposes of meeting all general operating expense of the District during the 2001 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 0 mills upon each dollar of the total valuation of assessment of all taxable property within the District for the year 2000.

B. Levy for Debt Service Fund. That for the purposes of meeting all debt retirement expense of the District during the 2001 budget year, as the funding requirements of the current outstanding general obligation indebtedness is detailed in the attached "Certification of Tax Levies," there is hereby levied a tax of 30.000 mills upon each dollar of the total valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the District for the year 2000.

C. Temporary Tax Credit or Rate Reduction. That pursuant to Section 39-1-111.5, C.R.S. for the purposes of effect of a refund for the purposes set forth in Section 20 of Article X of the Colorado Constitution, there is hereby certified a temporary property tax credit or temporary mill levy rate reduction of 0 mills upon each dollar of the total valuation of assessment of all taxable property within the boundaries of the District for the year 2000.

D. Levy for Abatement. That for the purposes of recoupment of the abatement of taxes pursuant to Section 39-10-114(1)(a)(I)(B), C.R.S., there is hereby levied a tax of 0 mills upon each dollar of the total valuation of assessment of all taxable property within the boundaries of the District for the year 2000.

Section 5. Property Tax and Fiscal Year Spending Limits. That, being fully informed, the Board finds that the foregoing budget and mill levies do not result in a violation of any applicable property tax or fiscal year spending limitation.

Section 5. Property Tax and Fiscal Year Spending Limits. That, being fully informed, the Board finds that the foregoing budget and mill levies do not result in a violation of any applicable property tax or fiscal year spending limitation.

Section 6. Certification. That Kevin R. Smith as Secretary of the District is hereby authorized and directed to certify by December 15, 2000, to the Board of County Commissioners of Summit County, Colorado, the mill levies for the District hereinabove determined and set. That said certification shall be in substantially the form set out and attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

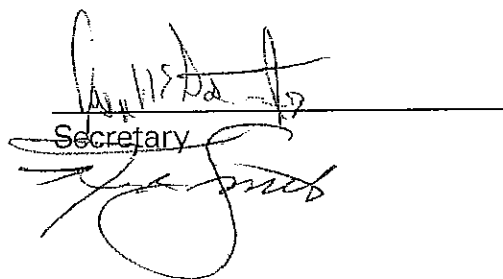

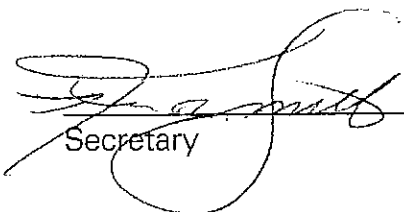
