Required Maintenance July 11, 2023

Dear Alpensee Water District Consumers,

The Alpensee Water District (AWD) is continuing its efforts to bring the system up to full utility, operational capacity, and planned redundancy. This work is required for ongoing reliability and safety in the District.

During this work, the High Flow Pump removed on March 7 will be reinstalled in the Alpensee Water district pump room 10 Farmers Ln. unit number six. Preparation work will begin on July 10 in the afternoon and a section of the southernmost parking lot of Alpensee III will be taped off. The water district asks that all people refrain from parking in the area where the crane will be parked at the south end of the parking lot. Crane operations will begin at about 8:00AM on July 11, 2023 and should be completed by noon. As in all planned work, there are issues that can come up to delay progress.

Later in the afternoon on July 11 work will begin to test the pumps. There may be some hydrants where water is discharged. Please do not approach these areas.
